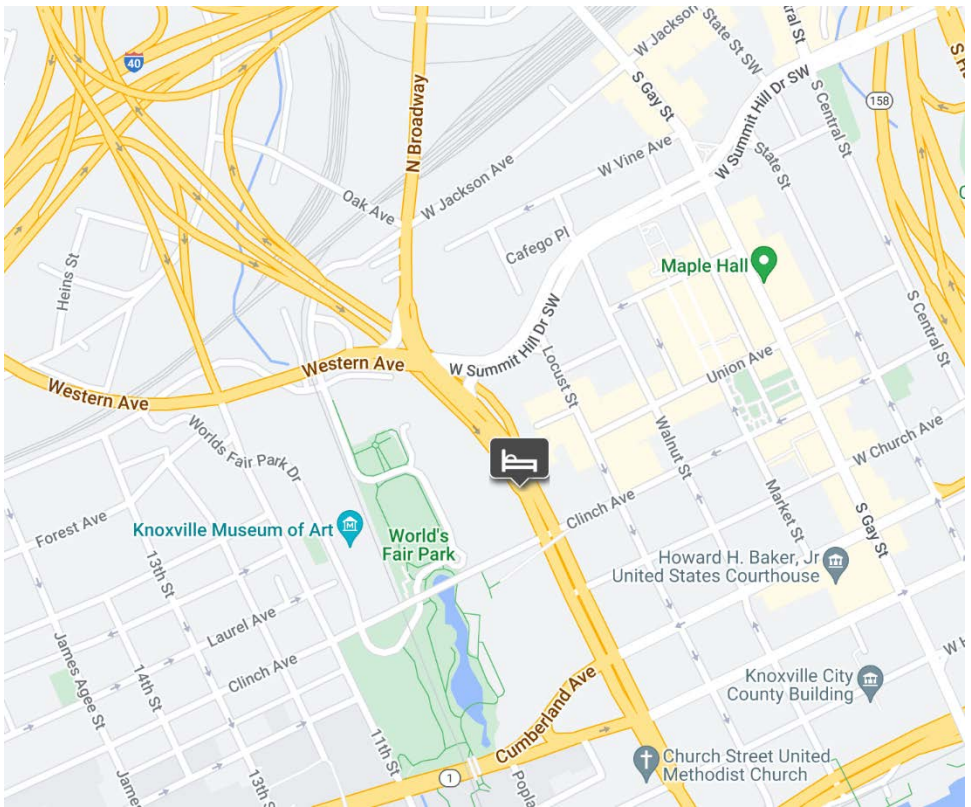

OBEDIENCE and RALLY EXHIBITORS

Crating space will be available near the Obedience/Rally ring free of charge and shall be removed 30 minutes following the trial. This courtesy is extended to only those dogs entered in the Obedience and/or Rally Trials. Hours: May be used on Sunday after 6pm and Monday only, during the trials, and up to one hour before trials start and one hour after trials end. Crates found set up outside these hours will be removed.

TRICK CONTEST

On Wednesday evening during happy hour bring your best tricks for a fun contest! Each dog will perform one trick, then the three dogs judged to have the best trick will perform up to three more tricks to determine the winner. Tricks will be judged on difficulty, creativity and accuracy by a three-judge panel. Prizes for top three finalists. A "People's Choice" award will also be given with audience voting held following the contest, to be announced at the National Specialty Banquet/Awards Ceremony on Friday. BEST ALL-AROUND BULLDOG CONTEST

Special AKC-Approved Event Sponsored by the BCA's Performance and Civic Activities Committee (PCAC). Contest winners (1st-4th place) will be based on the greatest number of points accumulated from the dog's entries and results in five categories: (1) Conformation Show, (2) Junior Showmanship, (3) Obedience and/or Rally Trials, (4) CGC and/ or Trick Dog Evaluations and (5) Fun Zone Activities and/or Best Trick Contest. Dogs must participate in at least three of the five categories to be eligible for the contest. Ties will be broken by coin flip as needed. This contest includes only the shows, trials and activities held during the 2022 National Specialty week (Monday, November 21 thru Friday, November 25, 2022). All the Conformation shows and Junior Showmanship classes Monday through Friday are included as options; however, contestants will be required to choose only one show to count for contest points. Prizes: 1st - \$150 cash, gift basket and rosette, 2nd - \$100 cash, gift basket and rosette, 3rd - \$75 cash, gift basket and rosette, 4th - \$25 cash and rosette. Point Structure:

- 1 point = entering Conformation Show*, Juniors*, Obedience Trial and/or Rally Trial
- 1 point = entering Trick Contest
- 1 point = participating in a Fun Zone booth educational activity (Scent 'n Go, Agility, Lure Coursing, Rally, etc.)
- 1 point = evaluation for CGC and/or Trick Dog titles
- 2 points = passing requirements for title in CGC and/or Trick Dog, qualifying in Rally and/or Obedience trial
- 4 points = 1st in class, 3 pts = 2nd, 2 pts = 3rd, 1 pt = 4th (Conformation, Juniors, Rally, Obedience)
- 5 points = High Combined score in Rally, High Combined score in Obedience, High Score in Obedience High Triple Combined in Rally, BOB, BOW, BOS, SD, SB, AOM, WD, WB, RWD or RWB in Conformation, Best Junior Handler.

***Conformation & Juniors Contestants must choose one show to use to count for contest points**

Scoring example: You enter a conformation show (1 point), you win first place (4 points), you win reserve (5 points), you take a CGC evaluation (1 point) you pass the CGC (2 points), you participate in three Fun Zone educational activities (3 points), you enter a rally trial (1 point), you qualify (2 points), but don't get a placement (0 points), and you enter an obedience trial (1 point), you qualify (2 points) and you get a third place (2 points) = 24 points! The more you do, the better chance you have to win!

- Forms will be available at the Welcome Desk and the Fun Zone (Fun Zone location: Obedience/Rally ring).
- Completed forms, ready for submission, must be turned into the Fun Zone Booth no later than one hour after Conformation judging is completed on Friday.
- Winners will be announced and prizes will be awarded at the National Specialty Banquet/Awards Ceremony on Friday evening.
- AKC registered Bulldogs, intact or not, 6 mos. or older are eligible

Misuse of SHOW SITE includes but is not limited to the following rules.

1. Smoking in non-smoking areas or rooms.
2. Allowing dogs to relieve themselves in areas other than those clearly designated for that purpose.
3. Failure to clean up after any dog in your care in any area, at any time.
4. All dogs must be in crates in rooms. Bathrooms are not considered a crate area and are not to be used to house dogs.

At the discretion of the Event Committee or the hotel/motel's housekeeping staff, rooms may be inspected at any time.

In the event of a complaint should it be determined by a hearing that destruction and/or misuse of property is occurring, the following steps shall be taken to correct the matter.

1. Monetary restitution shall immediately be made to the hotel/motel by violator (s).
2. The person (s) found in violation of the hotel/motel or AKC / The Bulldog Club of America rules shall be asked to leave the premises immediately.
3. If suspended from AKC privileges, the offender's name (s) shall be published in The AKC Gazette and The Bulldogger as having violated said rules.

The Bulldog Club of America retains all rights to photograph or videotape by any means and televise or reproduce these events in any way, now and in the future.

CARE OF THE SHOW SITE

Care for the show site is of utmost importance to the Bulldog Club of America. Whenever it shall be determined that misuse of a hotel or motel room or show site is occurring, the Bench Show Committee shall convene for the express purpose of an on-site inspection of the area in question. Should it be determined, by a hearing, that destruction and/or misuse of property is in fact occurring, the following steps shall be taken to correct the matter. Monetary restitution shall immediately be made to said hotel or motel by the violator (s) and the person, or persons, found in violation of the hotel or motel and AKC and BCA rules shall be asked to leave the premises immediately, and If suspended from all AKC privileges, the offender's name (s) shall be published in the AKC *Gazette* and The *Bulldogger* as having been found guilty of the said AKC/BCA rules.

ALL DAMAGES TO THE HOTEL ARE THE USER'S RESPONSIBILITY. ALL DOGS PRESENT MUST BE ON A LEASH OR CONFINED TO THEIR CRATES EXCEPT WHEN BEING JUDGED. THERE WILL BE NO ROOM FOR UN-ENTERED DOGS AT THIS SHOW. DOGS MUST BE CRATED AT ALL TIMES IN GUEST ROOMS, WHETHER OR NOT THE OWNER IS PRESENT! UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES SHOULD BULLDOGS BE ALLOWED ON GUEST BEDS OR BEDDING. NO DOGS OR FEED BOWLS ALLOWED IN PUBLIC HOTEL RESTROOMS. GUEST ROOMS ARE SUBJECT TO MANDATORY INSPECTION. THE ABOVE POLICIES WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED. PERSONS VIOLATING THESE RULES WILL BE SUBJECT TO ACTION BY THE EVENT COMMITTEE. OBEY ALL POSTED SIGNS. EXHIBITORS MUST BE GOVERNED BY ANY RULES OR REGULATIONS OF CIVIL AUTHORITIES.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

BULLDOGS ARE EXPECTED TO BE JUDGED ON A RAMP.

NO DOG WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE SHOW AREA EXCEPT THOSE ENTERED IN THE SHOW.

NO PUPPIES UNDER FOUR MONTHS OF AGE ARE ALLOWED AT THE SHOW HOTEL.

NO DOGS OR PUPPIES ARE TO BE SOLD AT THE SHOW SITE.

1. The hosting clubs may cancel any events due to extreme weather conditions.
2. The club is not responsible for loss or injury to anyone attending this show.
3. The club will not be responsible for the loss of or damage to any dog exhibited, regardless of the cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this show is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.
4. No dogs will be allowed in the show area except those entered in the show.
5. Dogs must be ready for judging. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.
6. Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.
7. All dogs must be on a leash or confined to crates except when being judged.
8. Do not leave any dogs in closed vehicles.
9. A dog which, according to its owners' records, has completed the requirements for a Championship after the closing of entries for the show, but whose Championship is unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to Best of Breed, provided this transfer is made by the Event Secretary at least one half hour prior to the start of any regular conformation Judging at the show.
10. Crates and grooming tables are not allowed within 10 feet of the rings.
11. Trophies and cash prizes will be awarded in the judging rings. In the event of a discrepancy from the published prize list, the Event Secretary should be advised at once. All trophies must be claimed the day of the show or be forfeited.
12. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.
13. All rights to advertise, publicize, televise, photograph or otherwise promote this event are vested in each individual club on its show date. All persons and animals on the Show Site at any time while the shows are in progress do, by attending and/or participating therein, grant to each club the right to photograph, televise, audiotape, videotape or otherwise use their likeness and voice in any manner without further release or consent.
14. Exhibitors must not wear anything in the ring identifying them with any club or organization.
15. No private ex-pens in grooming and show areas.
16. No bathing of dogs on show grounds, this includes hotel bathrooms.
17. Absolutely NO dogs shall not be left in grooming area overnight!
